We hope you enjoy the course and learn as much as possible.

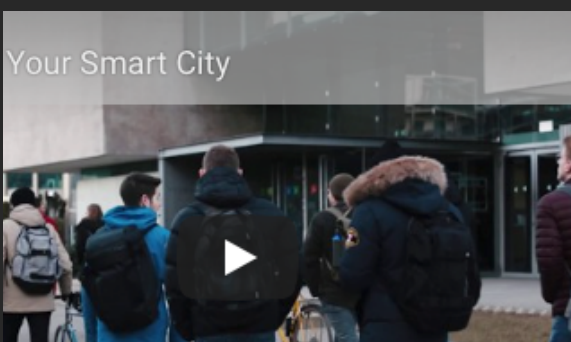
